

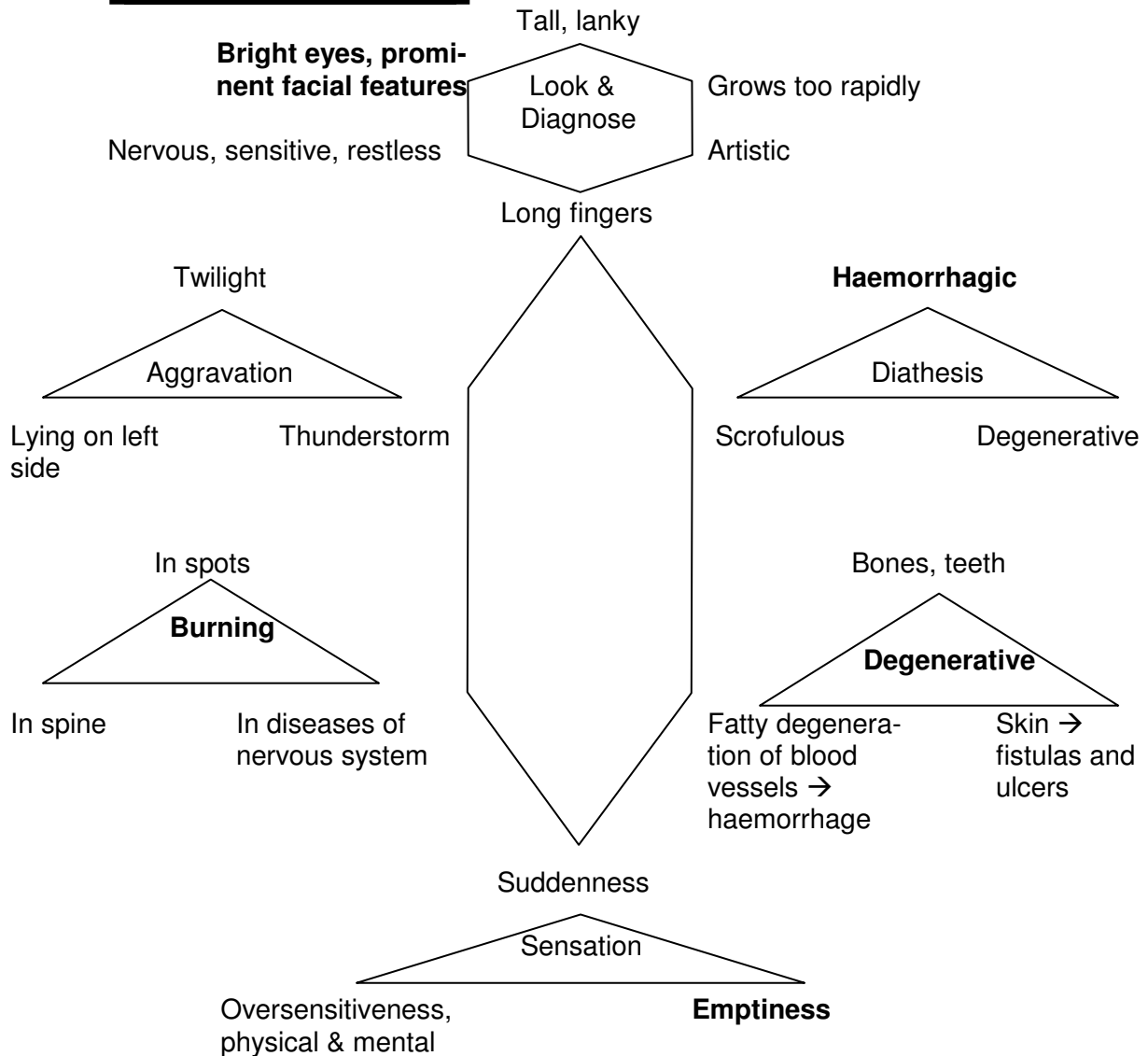

PHOSPHORUS

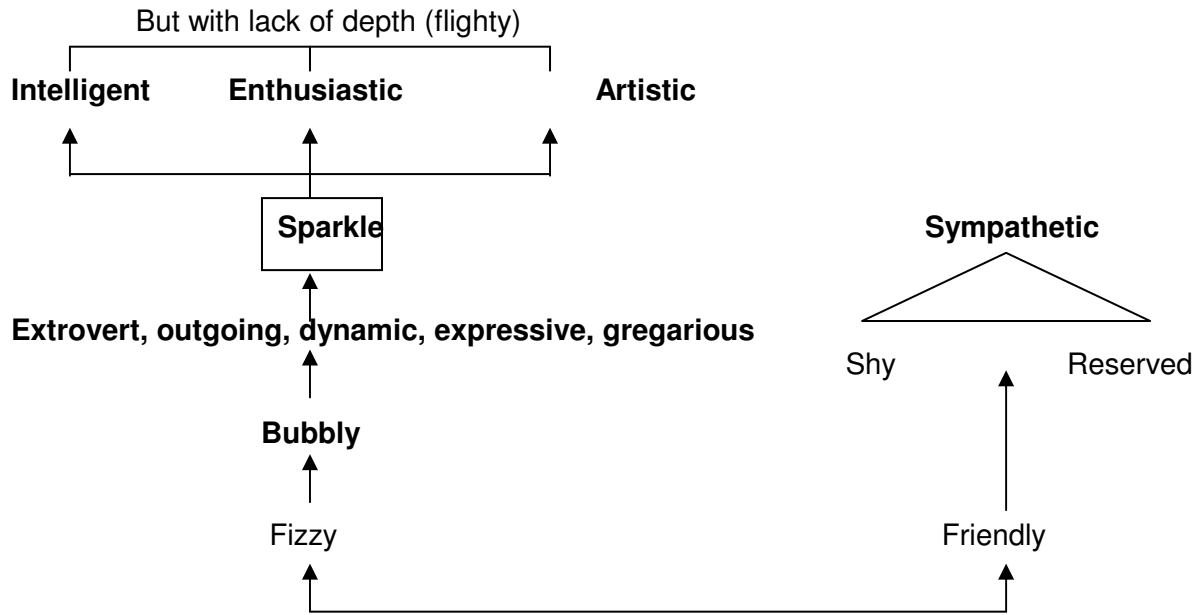
A. PHYSICAL THEME

B. MENTAL ESSENCE

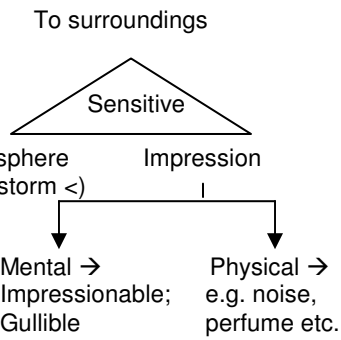


Fears

Emotions: diffuse outwards

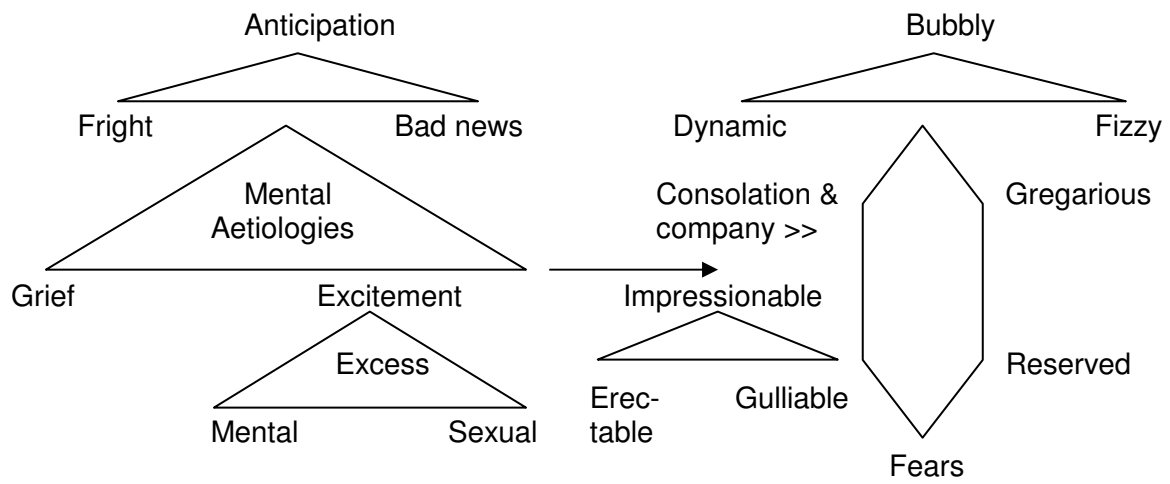

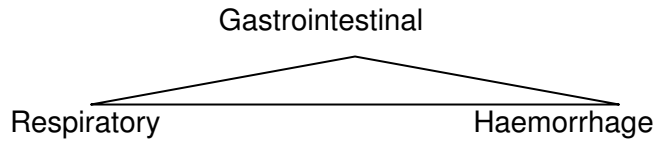

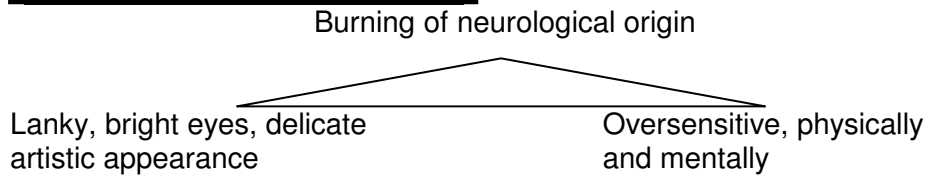

4. Nightmares.

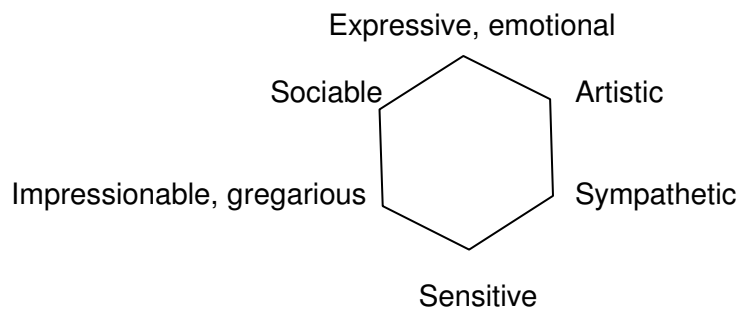
C. SPHERE OF ACTION: WEAKEST LINKS
