The project provides free homoeopathic treatment and milk to the children of the Calcutta slums.

The project began in 1986 and continues to be a reliable source of healthcare for people who:

- Live in small dwelling places without clean water
- Have the maximum of one meal a day
- Have large families and no access to education
- Have fled to Calcutta for safety due to anti Hindu riots in Bangladesh

In addition to free homoeopathic treatment the visiting Doctor advises on general health care and recommends when further investigations are required.

Calcutta is a city that welcomes everyone. It has twelve million inhabitants 40% of whom live in poor or very poor conditions. The seasonal changes bring challenges to those living with little means. The monsoon floods the small homes and encourages water borne diseases. The temperature can reach 40 degrees causing heat stroke and food contamination. Winters bring regular epidemics of pneumonias and influenza.

The health care provided by this project makes an significant difference to three regions of Calcutta and to the children who would otherwise just have a little rice and lentils for their one meal a day. The milk provided twice a week provides some of the essential nutrients necessary for their growth.
